PLANNING THE SCHEDULE OF YOUR GROUP

Upon receipt of your registration, someone from the office in charge of pilgrimages will contact you and enquire about your preferences and make suggestions.

TYPICAL PROGRAMME

(The times shown are hypothetical. You choose your departure time.)

- 9:00 a.m. Arrival and procedures
- Group welcome by a spiritual leader in one of the Old Quebec chapels *(this person will accompany the group throughout the day)*
 - Prayer offering of the pilgrimage
 - Presentation of the annual theme *(2016 : Mercy)*
- 9:15 a.m. Sharing the Word of God
- 9:45 a.m. Instructions for the Holy Door and the walk
- Walk *(5 to 15 minutes depending on the location of the chapel)*
- 10:00 a.m. Prayer at the Holy Door and the major reliquary of Saints and Blessed of Canada *(2016: crossing of the Holy Door)*
- 10:15 a.m. Tomb of Saint François de Laval *(prayer)*
- 10:30 a.m. Departure



POSSIBLE ADDITIONS:

- Our founders: Saint François de Laval, Saint Marie de l'Incarnation and the Blessed Marie-Catherine de Saint-Augustin. Possibilities: prayer at their graves, *(3 different chapels in the Old Quebec)*, teachings, video at the *Centre d'animation François de Laval*.
- Sacramental celebrations of forgiveness and the Eucharist:
 - Sacrament of Reconciliation: express your needs on this subject when booking *(one priest available prior to Mass unless there is a reservation)*.
 - Possibility of celebrating the Eucharist with the parish community (in French) [according to the schedule of the site](#), or a private celebration *(if the group is accompanied by a priest)*.
- Free visit of the boutique at the Museum of the Cathedral or the crypt *(in season)*.
